Bibliographical references/quotation: all quotes and bibliographical references included in the text must follow the *Chicago Manual of Style: Author-Date* reference system (16th Edition).

Length: Reviews will not be considered unless they have between 700 and 1500 words. Moreover, they must be accompanied by the author's full name, individual e-mail address and a brief bionote.

Working languages: Portuguese and English.
