Teaching Fellowship Duties:

- 1. To give classes in the written and oral use of European Portuguese at undergraduate level (from complete beginners to an advanced level) up to a maximum average of 6 hours in each week of term.
- 2. To regularly set, mark and grade students' work during the academic year.
- 3. To provide reports on attendance and progress for tutors as required.

- 4. To take part as an assessor or additional examiner in oral examinations (for which separate payment will be made).
- 5. To participate in the Sub-Faculty's one-week pre-sessional course, taking place in September each year.
- 6. To participate in the Sub-Faculty's one-day intensive Portuguese language course once a year.
- 7. To carry out administrative duties in the Sub-Faculty/Portuguese Centre as required.
