The theme of the event will be "Culture and Diversity in the teaching of Portuguese as an Additional Language (PAL)" and will be constituted by plenary sessions, roundtables and individual papers.

Paper format: 15 minutes (in Portuguese or English) + 5 minutes for questions

Abstracts should

- be 300 and 400 words (excluding references);
- be written in Portuguese or English;
- be sent to <u>sinepla.contato@gmail.com</u> no later than 15 January 2018, indicating *Abstract by AUTHORS' NAMES* in the field "subject" of the e-mail;
- be presented in the following format: title, scientific domain/theme, objectives, rationale and (preliminary) results;
- include names, e-mails and affiliation of authors.

One person can submit at most one abstract as sole author and one abstract as co-author.
