Individual Papers

Topics of presentations:

- teaching and assessment of PAL in different contexts;
- development of materials to be used online or face-to-face;
- teaching of translation;
- teaching of culture and literature from Portuguese-speaking countries.

Abstracts should

- be 300 and 400 words (excluding references);
- be written in Portuguese or English;
- be sent to sinepla.contato@gmail.com no later than 15 January 2018, indicating *Abstract by AUTHORS' NAMES* in the field “subject” of the e-mail;
- be presented in the following format: title, scientific domain/theme, objectives, rationale and (preliminary) results;
- include names, e-mails and affiliation of authors.

One person can submit at most one abstract as sole author and one abstract as co-author.
