Dos Algarves: A Multidisciplinary e-Journal (DAMeJ) invites the submission of original papers for issue 35, to be published in November 2019.

• **DAMeJ** is an open access and indexed journal (Latindex; DOAJ; REDIB; EBSCO) that publishes scientific and scholarly work in the research fields of: Tourism, Hospitality, Business, Finance (including Accountancy and Law), Social Sciences (applied to Tourism, Hospitality and Business research), applied ICT and Applied Linguistics (with a special focus on Languages for Specific Purposes).

Deadline for submission: 2 April 2019.

**DAMeJ** publishes two issues per year and accepts the following types of submissions: full research articles, critical literature reviews and research reports. The journal is multilingual, publishing articles in English, Portuguese and Spanish. We publish a general issue in November and, since 2014, a special issue in May, coordinated by guest editors.

#### Full research article

- We invite full research article which are the result of original, empirical research;
- Between 5,000 and 7,000 words (including figures, tables and references);
- Abstract (150 words);
- 5 keywords that describe the article for indexing purposes.

#### Critical literature review

- We invite critical literature reviews of theoretical, conceptual or methodological nature, which advances scholarship by providing original, insightful and useful perspectives on some aspects of tourism, management and hospitality;
- It should include clear aims and conclusions;
- Up to 2,500 words;
- Abstract (100 words);
- Up to 5 keywords that describe the article for indexing purposes.

### Research report

- We invite short research reports designed to present and discuss preliminary data and findings of a current research project (we do not accept research proposals). A research report should contain an introduction, a short and concise literature review, a description of the methodologies used, a presentation of key data with discussion and emerging conclusions.
- Up to 3,500 words;
- Abstract (100 words);
- Up to 5 keywords that describe the article for indexing purposes.

All submissions to **Dos Algarves: A Multidisciplinary e-Journal** follow a three-step selection and review process: (i) initial selection by the editors; (ii) double blind peer review by experts in the research area (iii) final review by a language specialist. With the aim of promoting freely available scientific and academic knowledge, our journal follows an **open access policy**. Our journal **does not have any article processing charges** or submission charges.
