The <u>Institute of Contemporary History</u> (IHC), a leading Portuguese research centre in the field of Modern and Contemporary History, welcomes applications for six-years Research Contracts, funded by the FCT - Foundation for Science and Technology, acting as host institution in the framework of the fourth edition of the <u>Individual Call to Scientific Employment Stimulus</u>.

The IHC has facilities both at <u>NOVA University Lisbon</u> and at the <u>University of</u> <u>Évora</u>. We foster interdisciplinary approaches and cover a wide range of topics concerning the conceptualisation, contextualisation, and interpretation of the historical reality for the period between the late eighteenth century and the present time. We also host a <u>Digital Humanities Lab</u>, an interdisciplinary space where knowledge in the Arts and Humanities can converge with methodologies from the Computational Sciences.
